

"CAR"dboard Cruise In Kick Off for the Kids!








Customize a wearable cardboard box into a car and cruise in for a movie & snacks before the parade.

How to Make a Cardboard Box Car



1. Seal a large box with packing tape.



Fold the cut top of the box to create a windshield. Then tape the top fold to its bottom half.




 Have an adult use a box cutter to cut out a semicircle on each side to make the doors. Then cut two thirds of the top of the box, leaving it joined to the car's "hood."



4. Have a grown-up cut out a windshield.



5. Glue on paper-plate wheels.



6. Attach plastic-cup lights with glue.



Get a custom paint job using finger and tempera paints.



Add upholstery by gluing fabric or construction paper to the inside of the car.
